**Wednesday Noon Bible Study** with Pastor Don - Have you been blessed? Our upcoming bible study asks us to consider our treasures. Beginning **Wednesday noon, February 24<sup>th</sup> for six weeks** we will study the book 'The Treasure Principle.'
