Women of the ELCA will be sponsoring a bake sale on Saturday, March 27, beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Bethany Hall.

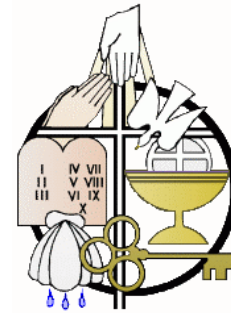
